





Book: The Art of Western Saddles

Undoubtedly one magnificent book about western saddles. It have a pageantry of great photos, but textually could it perhaps had been more depth,or wider!. You are not sitting back with the same understanding of the carvings and braidings as is on the photos as part of the saddles development. But so are perhaps the book written more for a american "insider" market, than for a reader "outsider" as try to understand this part of history as is said to have its origin in the moorish culture in Spain. Central in development of the american cowboy/western saddle is the vaquero culture, that orginated in the centuries after the spanish conquestdadores conquering of Mexico, the conquestadores also brought a leather culture with them! The vaqueros, i.e. mexican cowboys as

centuries later led cattles along the Rio Grande river under the goldrush in California on the end of the 1840's had developed theire horse gear in a way as was picket up by cowboys in Texas. It later led forward to todays art and craft on the field over whole America, non say the world. And by that can the history be sense quite different, depending on wher you are, and not least which book you accidentally must come to read in. In Bruce Grant's book Encyclopedia can you get the impression that it was the bradings as was central, at Bill Reynolds that it was the decorating of the saddle with silverwork. The book is allmost about it, even it it has great exampels as show that the author have viwe for both history and the simple genuine craft. In addition to silverwork show the photos embrodery, toolingwork and braidings, such one gets a composite picture of the western saddle as art object and use object.

The boots golden age, describes the author, to be between 1940-1965. While he refer among other to the movie Urban Cowboy with John Travolta starring in the time 1970-1990 when the boots production was on botten and the movie created a boots trend in USA as ended after 5 years. But it was something as was with on to save this populare footwear. And possible reached this trend fare north in the world up

under the north pole also, all the time I brought my first and only boots I ever have had in this time, without I can remember if Urban Cowboy was set up on norwegian cinemas? The later years development from about 1990 until today call the author the "plantinum age". Then developet the boots making itself from a advanced craft to art. The boots became also small art objects. First part of the book ia about boot biography, The other half mention 28 bootmakers/companyes in USA illustrated with photos as show example on production. The author manage to make it interesting, living and personal together with the photographer Jim Arndt as delever splendid photos from begining to the end. The only remarkable as not are to blame the author or photagrapher is how the book outside the boot eras centre looks to withdraw attention, while you think that the development as have taken place since 1990's must concern everyone as work with art and craft, regardless of genre. Anyhow are the book recommanded everyone. A end chapter deals with buying a pair of boot from a bootmaker. So follow a glossary. And a survey over 186 bootmakers in USA and only two outside.
