


Changes for american periodicals.





Louis B. Ortega is one of the real great artists inside of the western art. He was born in 1897 and died in 1995 and become nearly one hundred year. He startet at the age of twelve to learn about the traditional californian vaquero raw hide brading of Fernado Librado, one american indian vaquero as was over hundred years old, thus that theyer meeting by degrees should tie up the californian braiding tradition with over two hundred year until ouer days. This tradition have it's origin in the moorish/spanish culture in Spain and was brought to the new world of humans as followed after the conquestador Hernad Cortez when this congured Mexico, around two hundred year earlyer. This

braiding art developed it self in connection to the cattledrove, the use of the horse and it's equipment. The most about Louis B. Ortegas bradingart can perhaps be explained with the words of Louis Alberto Flores ,Bueno Aires,Argentina in 2002, and as is repeated in the books chapter < Braiding for Connoisseurs> on page 79, where it stays; < Is Ortega still the standard for braiding in your part of the world?>.Louis B. Ortega family was one of the first of spanish family as settled themself in California in 1700th century. His ancestor was a officer in the army and of that reason did they get farmland whereon they build a ranch as get a colorrich history in connection to the family until 1978. This is of course interesting, as well from a historical as from an art point of viwe to a reader as the undersigner as not have found any relevant littrature as could be outdeepend according to Bruce Grants books about braiding/history from ouer(leathercrafters) point of viwe.Bruce Grants books was published on the 1970's and as the most crafters from outside this bigger culturetradition learn about braiding from and perhaps get the first small insight from what consern history, Shortly said so is the book <Louis Ortega's Braiding Artistery, Braiding in the california tradition> an emty room where the wondering inside of a little field have been big, probably with many interested. But in main point is the book an biography about a human and an artist and perhaps a milieu as is away. And it have with many photos thus even without any knowlegde about the subject so gives the booksides a brilliant impression of an art as perhaps can be a little strange to an "northliver"
