





The magasin make attentive on this exhibition catalog made to an exhibition about the canadian artist Rex Lingwood's experimental cuir bouille works as was exhibited in both

Germany, Netherland, France and Canada between 1995-1997. Rex Lingwood is a sculptor as among other work with steel. He have also developed his own techniques in work with the old medeival cuir bouille technique by experiments through 10 years time. Cuir Boille is a process where the leather is boiling and formed over a wood! form before it gets hard as a result of the cooking process. And the exhibition/catalog show some of his works results. The textes "dicurse" the works/techniques and its place in art and craft today,...- something as also have resonance botten in a wide perspective conserning (leather) art and craft . All on four languages, Germany, Frence, Dutch and English on about 20 pages to each language of 90 pages all together with 38 colorphotos through the catalog as show works.
